



Do not light fires;


Do not pick flowers or take rock samples;


Be friendly towards local inhabitants. If necessary explain the purpose of your walk and point out the way-marks you are following

Municipal Festival - 22nd,23rd,24th,25th July, coinciding on the 25th with the


Feira da Terra - Local Produce Fair - usually on the weekend following the Municipal Festival (end of July/beginning of August).

Carry straight on along a very wide asphalt road until you reach a petrol station on the national road EN312. Go straight ahead for 100 metres to a little old farmhouse on the right From here take a forest path on your left which goes downhill.
